DEFINITION REMINDER

Regular Early Childhood Program
[Setting (44) Age 3-5 Codes 16, 17, 18, 19)]

- A program that includes a majority (at least 50 percent) of nondisabled children (i.e., children not on IEPs). This category may include but is not limited to: Head Start, **kindergarten**, preschool classes offered to an eligible pre-kindergarten population by the public school system, private kindergartens or preschools, and group child development centers or child care.
