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C4Learning: What is it?

- State-level item bank
of
- multiple choice items
in
- reading, mathematics and science
that are
- stored in the C4L online system
and
- used to generate interim assessments to “wrap around” NeSA tests.



How can C4L be used?

- Teachers, principals, or central office staff can identify items
to
- generate mini tests for use at point of instruction
so that
- a check for learning can occur
at
- any time throughout the year.

Who can be involved?

- All Nebraska districts
that
- agree to and sign an annual Memorandum of Understanding
with
- the Nebraska Department of Education.
- In 2012, 177 of 249 Districts signed up to participate.

2012-2013 Expectations

CHARTER Members

- Sign MOU by May 31, 2012
- No training required, video training available
- Submit 10 items per subject area (reading, mathematics, science) by August 1, 2012
- Attend item review (if requested) September 18-19, 2012 in Lincoln

NEW Members

- Sign MOU by May 31, 2012
- Attend June Trainings in Lincoln:
 - June 11-12 – Reading
 - June 18-19 – Mathematics
 - June 27-28 – Science
- Submit 10 items per subject area (reading, mathematics, science) by August 1, 2012
- Attend item review September 18-19, 2012 in Lincoln
